Sifton Properties Limited, Revel Shores Wastewater Servicing Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study

Sifton Properties Limited (Sifton) is undertaking a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study for the proposed future residential development in the Municipality of Lambton Shores, known as Revel Shores. The Study Area is approximately 81 hectares in size and shown on the key plan. The purpose of the EA study is to identify a recommended strategy for wastewater servicing for the proposed residential development.

The Process

The study will be undertaken in accordance with the requirements of Schedule 'C' projects, as outlined in the Municipal Class EA Document (2024), which is approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

Public Consultation

As part of the study, a comprehensive consultation process is being undertaken and your participation is encouraged. Two Public Information Centres (PICs) are included as part of this study. The first PIC will be hosted in-person to introduce this study and identify issues, needs and opportunities relating to the wastewater servicing systems for the proposed development. Members of the study team will be present to discuss the study with you and answer any questions you may have. This is a drop-in session with no formal presentation scheduled.
